International students who complete graduation requirements will receive a Bachelor's degree from their home institution together with a Bachelor of Arts in Management from Peking University.

Curriculum

The program will instill business fundamentals necessary for adapting to and succeeding in a shifting global landscape and will offer speciallydesigned courses focused on understanding China's Economy, Chinese through the program's China Immersion Finance, Chinese Management taught by Guanghua professors who are among the world's leading experts in these fields.

Cultural Acumen

With required Chinese language courses providing a solid foundation, students will be equipped to thrive in a Chinese context. They will be introduced to regional characteristics and policies Project and gain first-hand experience through dialogues with business leaders and government officials.

Scholarship

In recognition of admitted students' outstanding talent and leadership potential, the Peking University Belt & Road Institute will provide full merit-based scholarships covering students' costs at Peking University, including tuition fees, living accommodations, a living stipend, and off-site field visit costs.

Eligibility

Only students currently enrolled at one of the program's partner schools are eligible to apply.

Applicants must be among the top of their class and demonstrate exceptional promise; have a track record of leadership and social responsibility; and exhibit strong moral character, a clear sense of mission, and a global vision.



Application Process

Application timelines vary by institution, but the process typically starts at the beginning of a student's second academic year according to the following steps:

- 1) Application materials must be submitted through your home institution. PKU students will be recruited directly by Guanghua.
- 2) Nominations made to Guanghua.
- 3) Guanghua conducts secondary evaluations.
- 4) Admitted applicants notified.
